It is recognised that a number of units have high day case rates for procedures such as TURBT however, the variation across the country is significant.

National experts from GIRFT and BADS will share experience and advice about how to develop day case pathways for the large majority of urological surgery.

- Management of bladder cancer (TURBT pathways)
- Bladder outflow obstruction surgery – moving from TURP to daycase or outpatient procedures
- Major laparoscopic surgery as day cases
- Day case management of ureteric stones
- Novel anaesthetic approaches to urological surgery
- Pitfalls to approach and obstacles to overcome – how they did it
- The conference will also describe how urology investigation units can support your service to move procedures traditionally undertaken in a hospital environment into a community setting by embracing new technology.
